

ORDINANCE NO. 11182021

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 60
ADOPTED MAY 10, 1990, INCREASING THE FINE FOR
VIOLATIONS OF THE ORDINANCE IN ORDER TO DETER
VIOLATIONS OF THE ORDINANCE AND SETTING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE**

WHEREAS, it has been ascertained there are numerous violations of Ordinance No. 60 adopted May 10, 1990, regulating travel by trucks on the streets and highways of the City, which violations cause damage to certain portions of the streets and highways that are not suited for truck traffic, and which violations also put at risk the citizens of the City and other users of streets and highways not suited for truck traffic, and that an amendment should be made to Ordinance No. 60 increasing the fine for violations thereof in order to deter violations of said Ordinance.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROSE CITY, TEXAS:

Section 5 of Ordinance No. 60 adopted May 10, 1990, is hereby amended, and shall henceforth read as follows:

Sec. 5. Any person operating a truck in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine in an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation thereof.

This Ordinance becomes effective from and after its passage and publication.
